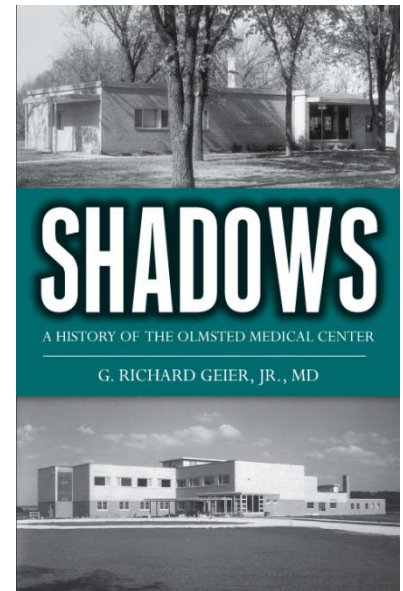
Public Invited to Attend Book Signing of *Shadows: A History of the Olmsted Medical Center*
