Olmsted Medical Center Scheduling H1N1 Vaccinations for at-risk Patients ONLY

Rochester, Minn.— Olmsted Medical Center (OMC) is scheduling a limited number of H1N1 vaccination appointments for current OMC patients at high risk for H1N1 infection.

A limited quantity of injected H1N1 vaccine is available, by appointment only, at the Rochester Southeast clinic, 210 Ninth St. SE (near Bethel Lutheran Church) in Rochester. Appointments will be scheduled between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM Wednesday, Nov. 18, and between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM Thursday, Nov. 19.

This H1N1 vaccination opportunity is available to current OMC patients who are at high risk for H1N1 infection. These patients include:

- Pregnant women
- All children 6 months to 4 years old
- Children 3–18 years old with chronic conditions including cancer, asthma, or immune deficiencies
- Anyone living with or caring for infants 6 months or younger

OMC also has a limited quantity of injected H1N1 vaccine for all children ages 5–9 years who are NOT current OMC patients. Children receiving this vaccine will be registered as new OMC patients.

All patients receiving these vaccinations will not be billed for the vaccine, but a vaccine administration fee will be charged to the patient or their medical insurance.
