Olmsted Medical Center Scheduling H1N1 Vaccinations for Current, Pregnant Patients ONLY

Rochester, Minn.— Olmsted Medical Center (OMC) is scheduling a limited number of H1N1 vaccination appointments for current OMC patients who are pregnant.

A limited quantity of injected H1N1 vaccine is available, by appointment only, at the Rochester Southeast clinic, 210 Ninth St. SE (near Bethel Lutheran Church) in Rochester. Appointments will be scheduled between 2:00 and 6:00 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 29, and between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Friday, Oct. 30.

Call 507.288.3443 to schedule an appointment.

Patients receiving these vaccinations will not be billed for the vaccine, but an administration fee will be charged to the patient or their medical insurance.

This limited quantity of H1N1 injected vaccine is currently only available to established OMC patients who are pregnant. The Centers for Disease Control and Minnesota Department of Health have identified pregnant women as at especially high risk for H1N1 infection.
