Rochester, Minn.— Olmsted Medical Center (OMC) will hold its ninth annual Honor Planting Service at its “Still Missed” Garden site, located at Olmsted Medical Center Hospital, 1650 Fourth St. SE, at 12:15 p.m. on Wednesday, May 19, 2009. The Garden is located to the right of the OMC Hospital’s main entrance (facing Fourth St. SE).

OMC’s “Still Missed” Garden provides community and support for families who have experienced loss (including perinatal loss) at Olmsted Medical Center. According to OMC registered nurse and event chair Nikki Gregor, “this annual event continues to give all of us who have experienced the loss of a loved one a time and place to honor their memories.” The garden is truly a living tribute to those memories, and those who attend the service are encouraged to bring an annual blooming plant to be added to the garden to honor and remember their loved ones.

The Honor Planting Service was begun in 2002 by OMC’s Perinatal Loss Committee, whose members represent several OMC departments and services. This year Alan Reed from the KWWK 96.5 Quick Country morning show will emcee the event. The service will be followed by a light lunch.
